Official estimates of unemployment in the UK are obtained from the Annual Population Survey (APS) using the internationally agreed International Labour Organisation (ILO) definition. The ILO definition is based on the number of people without jobs who are looking for work. The APS unemployment figures which are subject to sampling differences are only available for Local Authority (LA) areas. The Claimant Count is released on a monthly basis and is available down to ward level, so is used as a more current indicator of unemployment levels.

Unemployment and Sought Occupation

Figure 1 below shows the distribution of sought occupation and how this varies by geography. The data follows broadly similar patterns with most claimants seeking work in Elementary occupations. However, as can be seen, Leicester City and Leicestershire County areas have a higher percentage of unemployment claimants seeking work as Managers and Senior Officials than compared to the East Midlands and UK averages. Leicester City and Leicestershire County have a lower percentage of claimants seeking work in Skilled Trade occupations. Another interesting figure is that the County area has a higher proportion of claimants seeking work in Administrative and Secretarial occupations. Leicester City has a high proportion of claimants seeking work in Elementary occupations (38.7%).

Figure 1: Percentage of Unemployed by Sought Occupations: June 2006

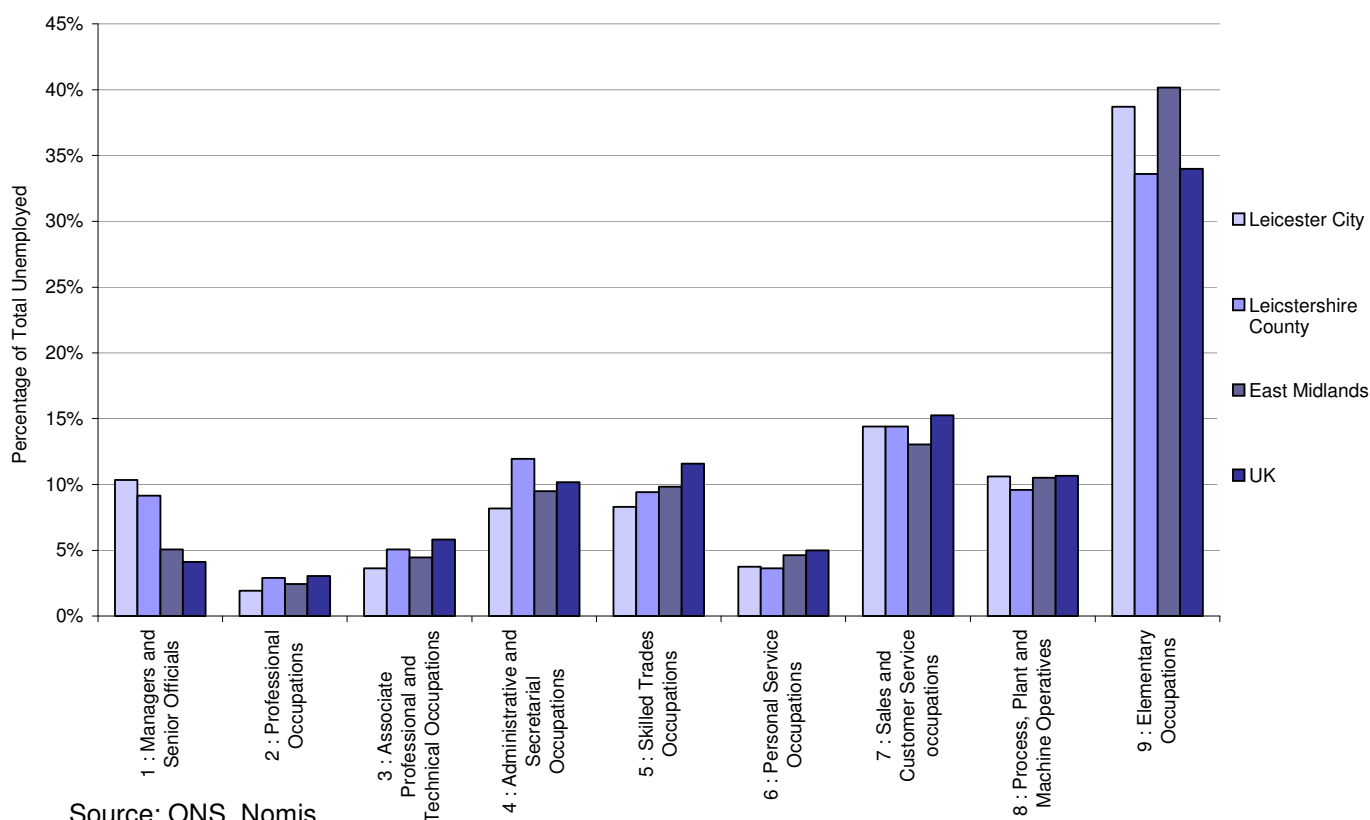
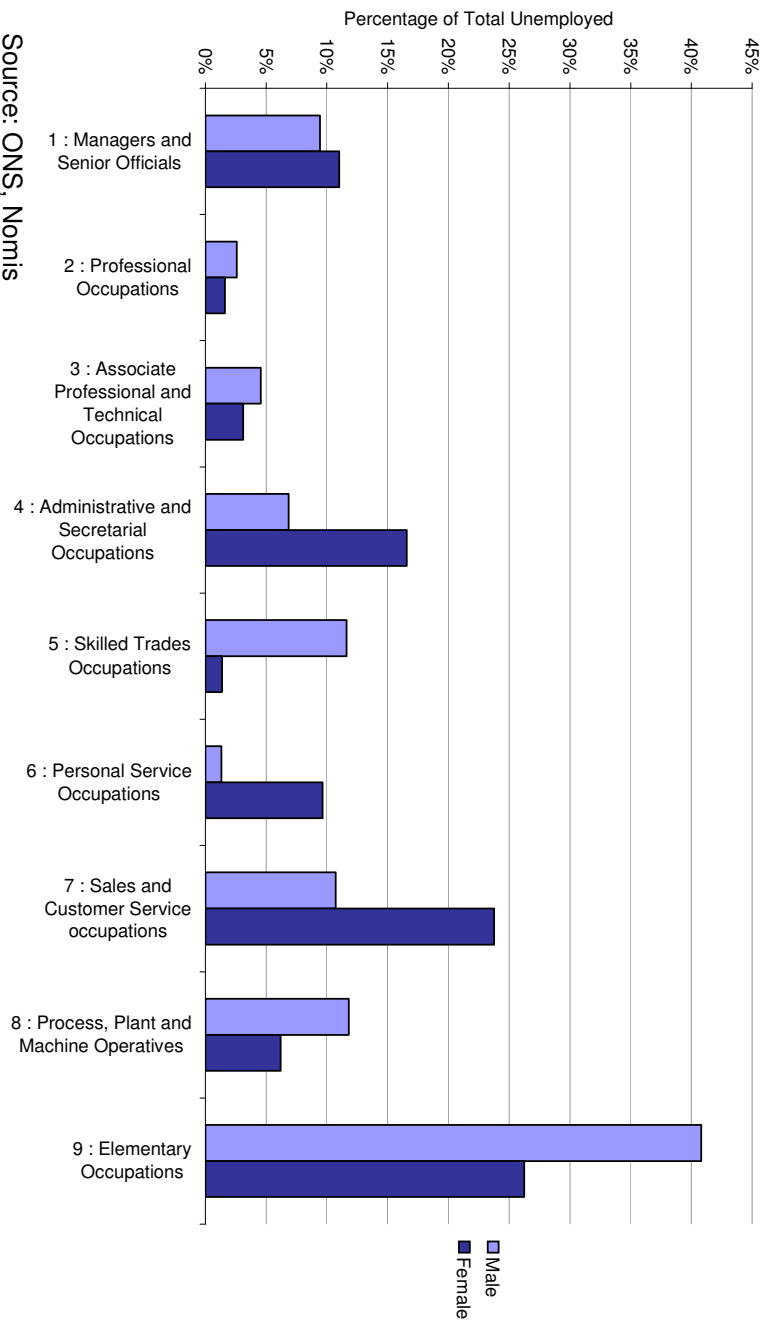


Figure 2 shows sought occupation by gender of claimants in Leicester Shire. Again the broad trends are the same with most claimants seeking work in Elementary occupations. However, there are interesting differences in preferred occupation by sex. A majority of female claimants seek work in Sales and Customer Service, Administrative and Secretarial, Elementary, or Personal Service occupations. Whereas, men in Leicester Shire tend to concentrate their search more in Elementary, Skilled Trades, and Process, Plant and Machine Operative occupations. Interestingly more women than men are seeking work as Managers and Senior Officials (11.0% compared to 9.4%).

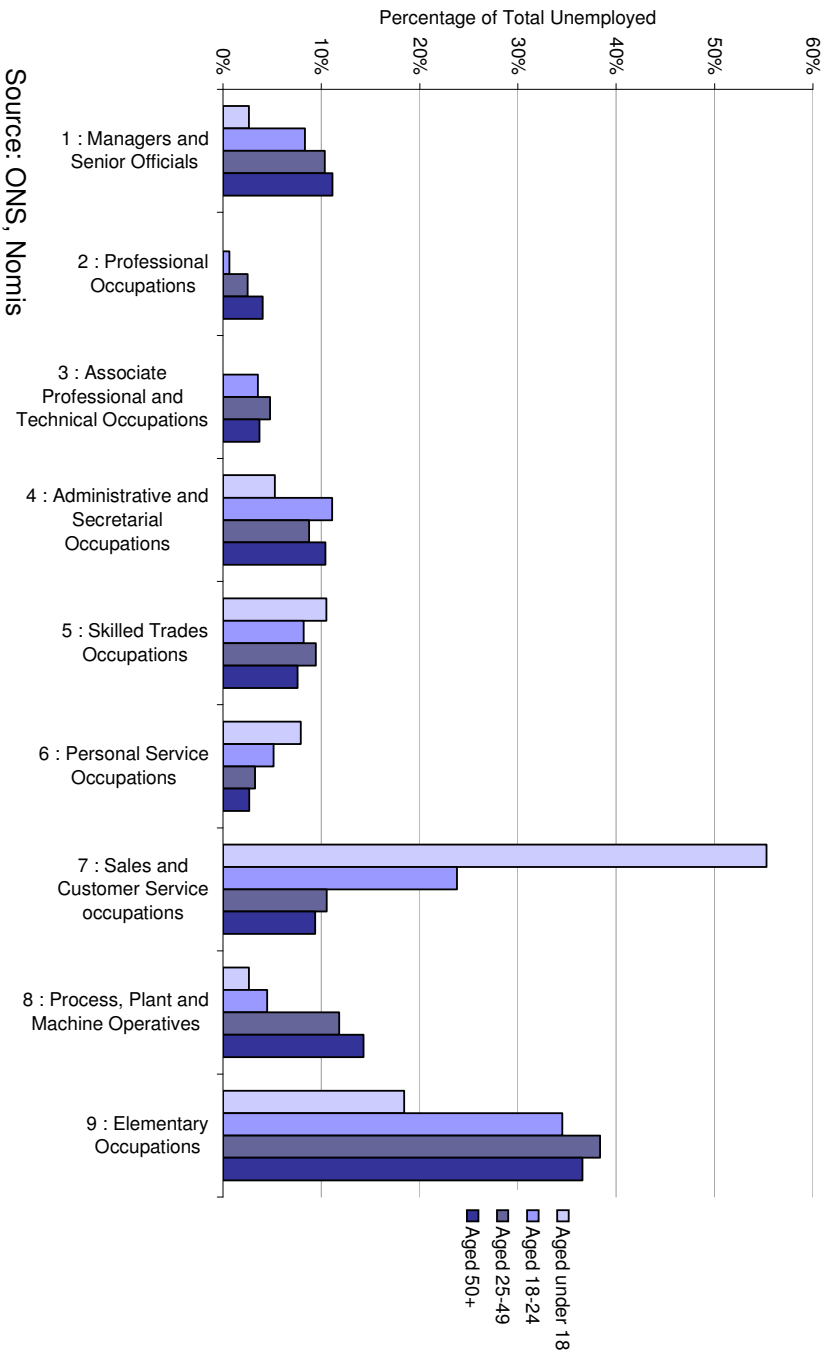
Figure 3 illustrates how the occupation sought by unemployment claimants differs by age. For the under 18 age group, compared to the overall trend, the Elementary occupations category does not attract the highest percentage of claimants, instead a higher proportion of this age group seek work in Sales and Customer Service occupations. This age group also has a higher proportion of claimants seeking work

in Skilled Trade and Personal Service occupations compared to the other age categories. People aged over 25 are more likely to seek work as Managers and Senior officials, in Professional occupations, Elementary Occupations, and as Process, Plant and Machine Operatives, and less likely to want work in Personal Service occupations.
