Official estimates of unemployment in the UK are obtained from the Annual Population Survey (APS) using the internationally agreed International Labour Organisation (ILO) definition. The ILO definition is based on the number of people without jobs who are looking for work. The APS unemployment figures which are subject to sampling differences are only available for Local Authority (LA) areas. The Claimant Count is released on a monthly basis and is available down to ward level, so is used as a more current indicator of unemployment levels.

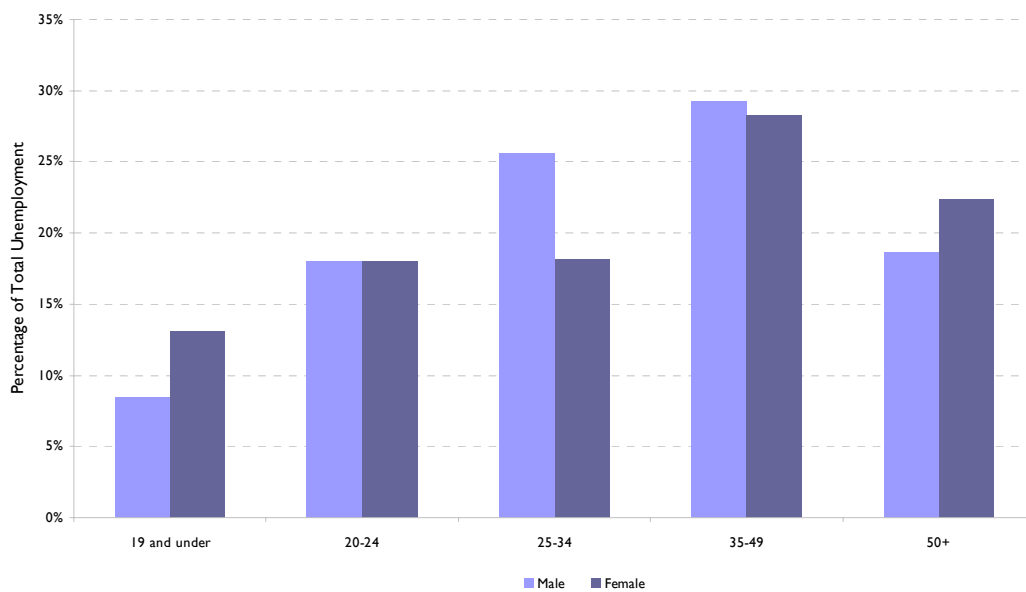
Unemployment by age

Analysis of unemployment by age shows various trends by gender and geographic area. Figure 1 shows the gender and age breakdown of Claimant Count unemployment for Leicester Shire. Overall, the greatest proportion of unemployed people of either sex are aged between 35 and 49 years old.

Females experience higher unemployment than males in the 19 and under age group, 13.1% compared to 8.5%. However, in the 25-34 age group male unemployment (25.6%) is much higher than female unemployment (18.2%). The percentage of males in this age group claiming Job Seekers Allowance (JSA) may be considerably higher compared to females because women are more likely to be classed as looking after the home or not be eligible for JSA due to their partners work status or combined income.

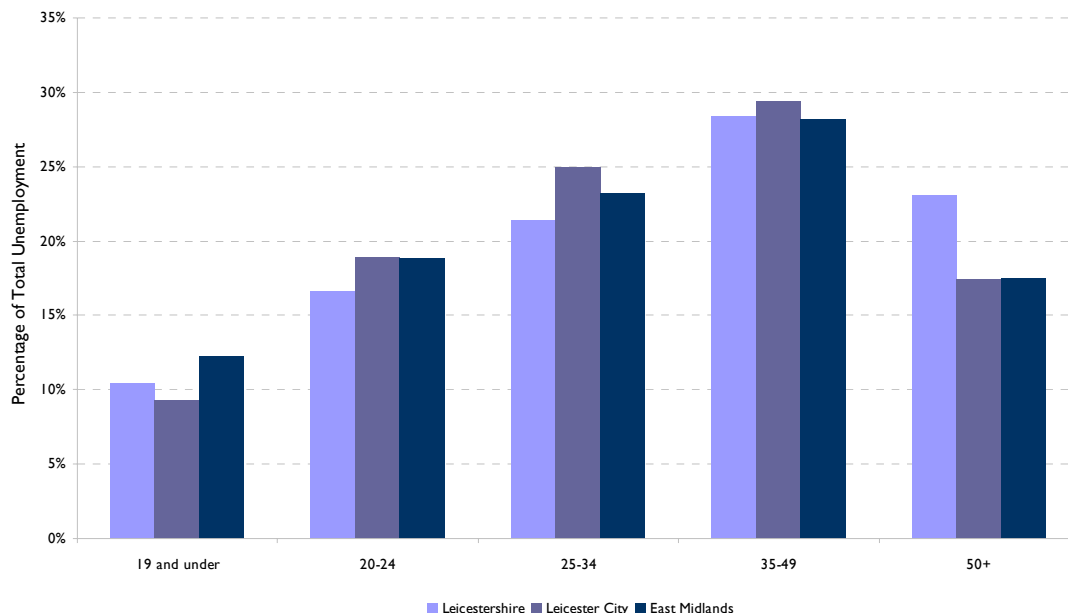
However, the gap between male and female unemployment in the 35-49 age group is much smaller (one percentage point) indicating that more women are actively seeking to return to the labour market perhaps as children grow up and become more independent.

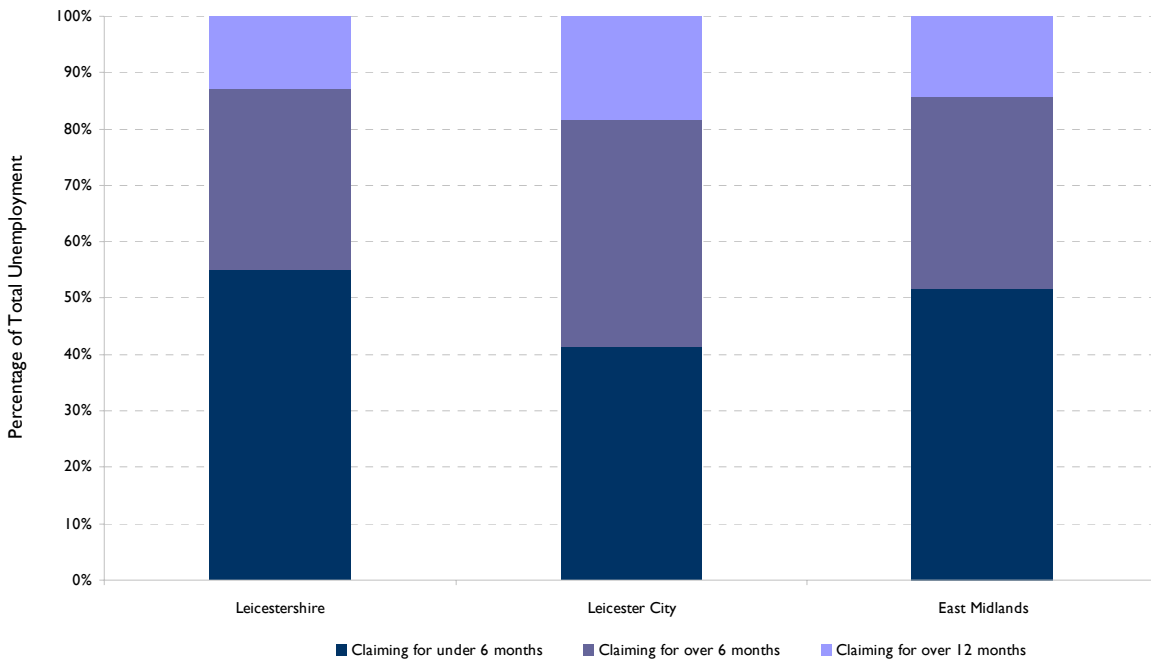
Figure 2: Claimant Count unemployment by age for Leicestershire County, Leicester City and the East Midlands

Figure 2 displays the differences in the characteristics of unemployed people between the County and the City areas. Leicester City has a higher percentage of unemployment in people aged 25-49 than both the levels in Leicestershire County and in the East Midlands region. As the age of claimants increases to over 50 years, Leicestershire County has a higher proportion of claimants than in the City or in the East Midlands. This is the only age category where Leicestershire has a higher proportion unemployed than in the East Midlands. This trend in higher unemployment in older people in the County area than the City, reflects the population profiles of the two areas, where the city is characterised by a younger population.

Figure 3 displays the a breakdown of Claimant Count unemployment by the length of time that people have been claiming. Leicestershire County has a higher proportion of people that have been claiming JSA for less than six months (55.1%), when compared to Leicester City (41.4%) and the East Midlands (51.7%). Leicester City has a much higher proportion of people that are long-term unemployed and have been claiming JSA for over 6 months. 58% of claimants in Leicester City have been claiming for over 6 months, compared to 45% in Leicestershire and 48.3% in the East Midlands.
