Introduction

The proposals in this report support the vision for Leicestershire Together as set out in the Sustainable Community Strategy 2008-2013. In particular, the consultation results will inform and ensure the Council and its partner's resources are focused on the delivery of the priorities for Leicestershire.

Background

The outcomes from the following consultations are incorporated in this report:

1. Leicestershire Together Forum – November 2008
2. Leicestershire Community Forums – Autumn 2008
3. Citizens Panel during December 2008 to January 2009

Leicestershire Together Forum, Leicestershire Community Forums and Citizens Panel

1. Key Stakeholder event

On 24th November 2008, the Leicestershire Together Forum met and discussed the priorities for the county of Leicestershire. The Forum has representatives from a range of communities including; Age, Asylum Seekers & Refugees, Black & Minority Ethnic (BME), Carers, Disability, Gender, Sexual Orientation, Transgender, Gypsy & Traveller Community and Religious/ Faith groups.

2. Community Forums

During autumn 2008, 19 community forums were consulted under the topic of 'Influencing the Big Budget'. This exercise involved using the

voting handsets to gain people's view on what they thought was most important and most worthy of investment. The remaining six forums meetings did not produce results because (a) there was a breakdown in technology and/or (b) because of time constraints and in one case, because the forum agreed not to complete the exercise.

3. Citizens Panel

During 15th December 2008 to 5th January 2009, Leicestershire County Council consulted its Citizen Panel to seek their view on the budget, approximately 350 responses were submitted by the panel.

Caution - Due to the low number of responses for each of the different events, the results must be treated with caution. In particular, the Leicestershire Forum event was attended by 18 people hence making the results less robust.

Table 1 provides a summary of responses from the Leicestershire Together Forum, the Leicestershire Community Forums and the Citizens Panel. The following key points are based on the most commonly chosen first choice response for each question from all the events:

- A safe and attractive place to live and work was seen as the most important area where major investment should be made
- To make Leicestershire a safe and attractive place to live and work, then tackling anti-social behaviour and disorder should be prioritised
- To improve life chances for vulnerable people and places in Leicestershire, investment should be prioritised for improving the quality of life in the most disadvantaged neighbourhoods in the county.
- To create stronger and build more cohesive communities, we need to ensure that people are involved and engaged in their community and play a role in the decision making process
- In order develop an effective response to climate change, more resources should be focussed on reducing the amount of waste produced and the proportion of that going to the landfill sites
- For Leicestershire to have a prosperous, innovative and dynamic

economy, more investment should be made in developing a highly skilled population with more people in high-value jobs

- To make Leicestershire a healthier place live, investment should be prioritised in enhancing access to sport, recreation and cultural activities
- So that all people in Leicestershire can enjoy a healthier lifestyle, investment should be prioritised for getting more people to be physically active
- To make service delivery more effective and efficient, enhancing access to facilities and services in the County should be a top priority

Chart 1—9 presents the results of the consultations carried out with the Community Forums together with the average for the forums and total for all consultations.

Chart 10 provides the demographic profile of the respondents.


