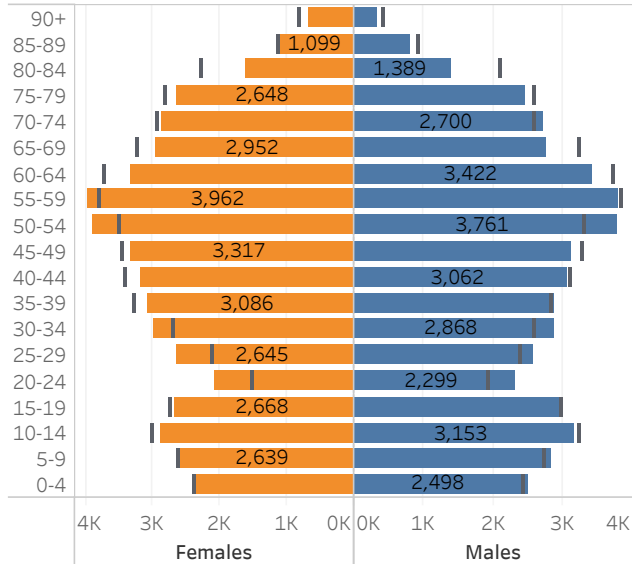

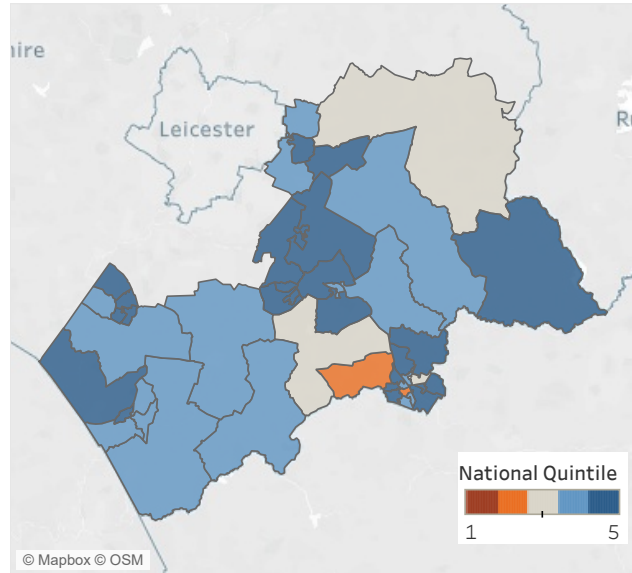
Population pyramid

Age and sex profile of residents, bars indicate 2022 Mid year population estimates, lines show projected 2027 population.



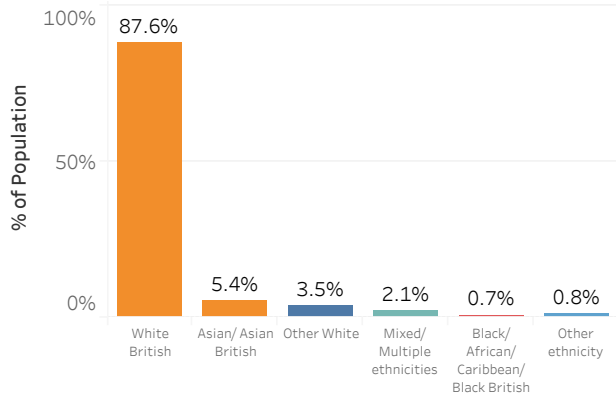
Index of Multiple Deprivation map

LSOA map showing national quintile performance of index of multiple deprivation score.



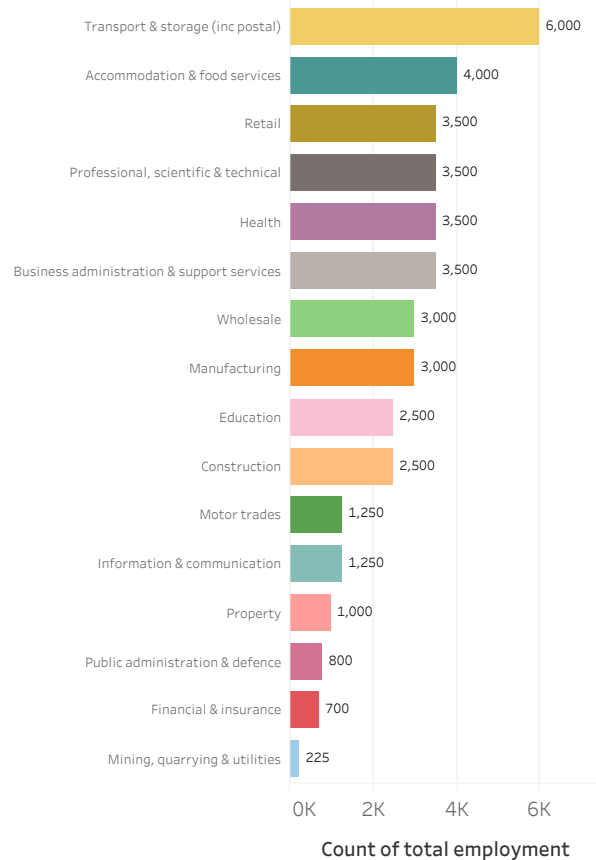
Ethnicity

Percentage of 2021 population by broad ethnic group.



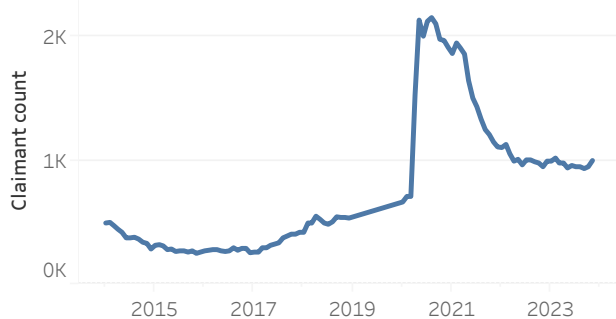
Occupations

Wider determinants

The number of premises licensed to sell alcohol per square kilometre in Harborough in 2021/22 is 0.6, this is significantly better than the England value of 1.3.



The percentage of the local authority population living in areas at highest risk of food insecurity for Harborough in 2021 is 1.6%, this is not compared to England.



The air pollution: fine particulate matter (new method - concentrations of total PM2.5) for Harborough in 2021 is 7.1 µg/m3, this is not compared to the England value of 7.4 µg/m3.



The percentage of people in employment in Harborough in 2022/23 is 76.5%, this is similar to the England value of 75.7%.



The average weekly earnings for Harborough in 2021 is £534.1, this is similar to the England value of £496.0.



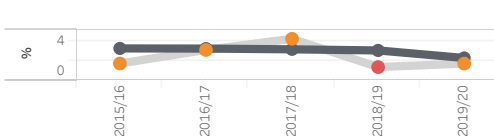
The gap in the employment rate between those with a long-term health condition and the overall employment rate for Harborough in 2022/23 is 8.5 percentage points, this is similar to the England value of 10.4 percentage points.



The rate of violence offences per 1,000 population for Harborough in 2021/22 is 20.0 per 1,000, this is not compared to the England value of 34.9 per 1,000.



The percentage of adults cycling for travel at least three days per week for Harborough in 2019/20 is 1.8%, this is similar to the England value of 2.3%.



The affordability of home ownership ratio (where a higher ratio indicates that on average, it is less affordable for a resident to purchase a house in their local authority district) for Harborough in 2021 is 8.9, this is not compared to the England value of 9.1.

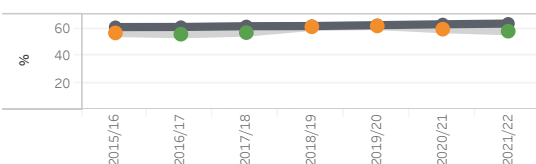


The percentage of the population living in fuel poverty for Harborough in 2021 is 10.4%, this is not compared to the England value of 13.1%.



Health behaviours

The percentage of adults (aged 18 plus) classified as overweight or obese for Harborough in 2021/22 is 58.2%, this is significantly better than the England value of 63.8%.



The smoking prevalence in adults (18+) - current smokers (APS) for Harborough in 2022 is 6.3%, this is significantly better than the England value of 12.7%.



The percentage of physically active adults for Harborough in 2021/22 is 68.7%, this is similar to the England value of 67.3%.



The percentage of adults aged 16 and over meeting the '5-a-day' fruit and vegetable consumption recommendations (new method) for Harborough in 2021/22 is 39.6%, this is significantly better than the England value of 32.5%.

Early years

The proportion of low birth weight of term babies for Harborough in 2021 is 2.5%, this is similar to the England value of 2.8%.



The proportion of women smoking at time of delivery for Harborough in 2022/23 is 7.4%, this is similar to the England value of 8.8%.



The infant mortality rate for Harborough in 2019 - 21 is 2.8 per 1,000, this is similar to the England value of 3.9 per 1,000.

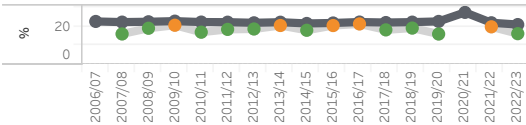


The rate of premature births (less than 37 weeks gestation) for Harborough in 2019 - 21 is 80.4 per 1,000, this is similar to the England value of 77.9 per 1,000.

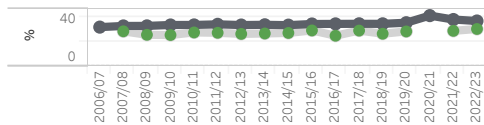


Wider determinants

The prevalence of overweight children (including obesity) in Reception for Harborough in 2022/23 is 16.5%, this is significantly better than the England value of 21.3%.



The prevalence of overweight children (including obesity) in Year 6 for Harborough in 2022/23 is 30.2%, this is significantly better than the England value of 36.6%.



0-18 The Child Poverty, Income deprivation affecting children index (IDACI) for Harborough in 2019 is 6.7%, this is significantly better than the England value of 17.1%.

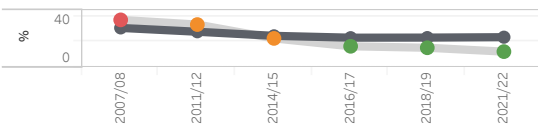
The percentage of children in absolute low income families (under 16s) for Harborough in 2021/22 is 10.5%, this is significantly better than the England value of 15.3%.

Pupil absence for Harborough in 2021/22 is 7.0%, this is significantly better than the England value of 7.6%.

The average attainment 8 score for Harborough in 2021/22 is 54.4, this is not compared to the England value of 48.7.

Outcomes

The percentage of 5 year olds with experience of visually obvious dental decay for Harborough in 2021/22 is 12.5%, this is significantly better than the England value of 23.7%.



The rate of admission episodes for alcohol-specific conditions - Under 18s for Harborough in 2018/19 - 20/21 is 25.7 per 100,000, this is similar to the England value of 29.3 per 100,000.



The rate of hospital admissions caused by unintentional and deliberate injuries in children (aged 0 to 14 years) for Harborough in 2021/22 is 46.9 per 10,000, this is significantly better than the England value of 84.3 per 10,000.



The under 18s conception rate for Harborough in 2021 is 5.2 per 1,000, this is significantly better than the England value of 13.1 per 1,000.

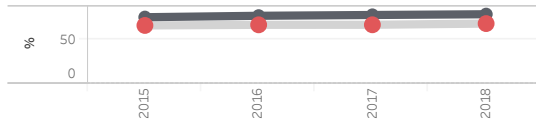

Diagnoses



The estimated diabetes diagnosis rate for Harborough in 2018 is 67.5%, this is significantly worse than the England value of 78.0%.



The estimated dementia diagnosis rate (aged 65 and older) for Harborough in 2023 is 56.5%, this is significantly worse than the target value of 66.7%.



The all new STI diagnosis rate for Harborough in 2022 is 331 per 100,000, this is significantly lower than the England value of 694 per 100,000.



The cancer screening coverage - breast cancer for Harborough in 2022 is 73.2%, this is significantly better than the England value of 65.2%.

Admissions

The rate of admission episodes for alcohol-related conditions (Narrow) for Harborough in 2021/22 is 406 per 100,000, this is significantly better than the England value of 494 per 100,000.



The rate of emergency hospital admissions due to falls in people aged 65 and over for Harborough in 2021/22 is 1,618 per 100,000, this is significantly better than the England value of 2,100 per 100,000.



Mortality



The under 75 mortality rate from causes considered preventable for Harborough in 2021 is 108.0 per 100,000, this is significantly better than the England value of 183.2 per 100,000.



The suicide rate for Harborough in 2019 - 21 is 8.8 per 100,000, this is similar to the England value of 10.4 per 100,000.



The under 75 mortality rate from cancer for Harborough in 2021 is 93.6 per 100,000, this is significantly better than the England value of 121.5 per 100,000.



The under 75 mortality rate from all cardiovascular diseases for Harborough in 2021 is 57.6 per 100,000, this is significantly better than the England value of 76.0 per 100,000.



The Mortality rate from chronic obstructive pulmonary disease, all ages for Harborough in 2021 is 17.3 per 100,000, this is significantly better than the England value of 39.8 per 100,000.



The winter mortality index for Harborough in Aug 2020 - Jul 2021 is 27.3%, this is similar to the England value of 36.2%.

Life Expectancy

The life expectancy at birth for males for Harborough in 2021 is 80.7 years, this is significantly better than the England value of 78.7 years.



The life expectancy at birth for females for Harborough in 2021 is 84.7 years, this is significantly better than the England value of 82.8 years.
