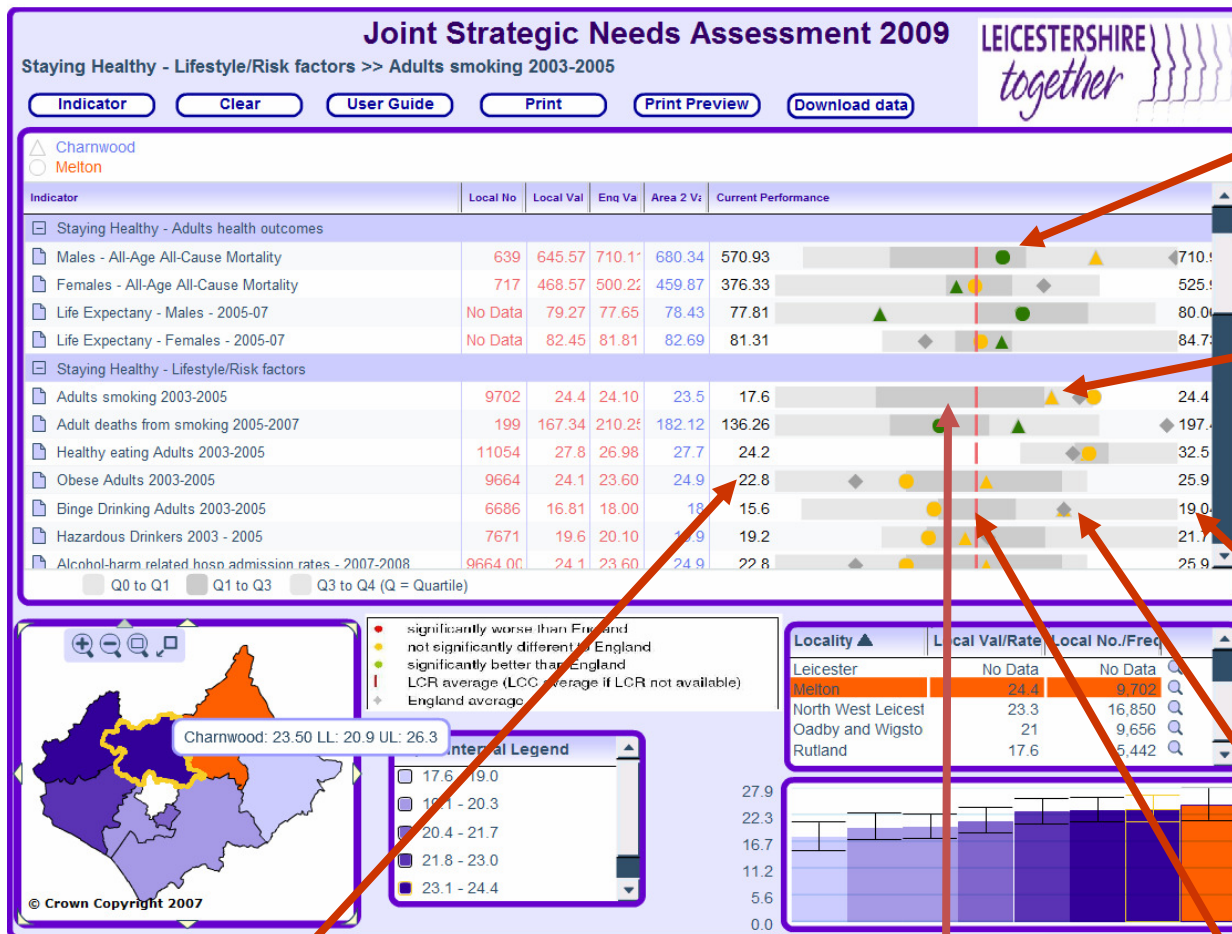


Interpretation of Spine Chart



The circle ● represents the indicator value for the selected locality (highlighted red in the map:– e.g. Melton). The colour of the circle will change according to whether it is better, worse or not significantly different to the England value.

The triangle ▲ appears on the spine chart when you hover over an area on the map and represents the indicator value for a second selected locality (outlined yellow on the map:– e.g. Charnwood).

This is the **maximum** value for the indicator.

◆ a grey diamond represents the England average.

The red centre line |, represents the Leicestershire County and Rutland average for each indicator (note: for some indicators the LCR value is not available and the LCC value is displayed.)

This is the **minimum** value for the indicator.

The grey bars represent the inter-quartile range.
