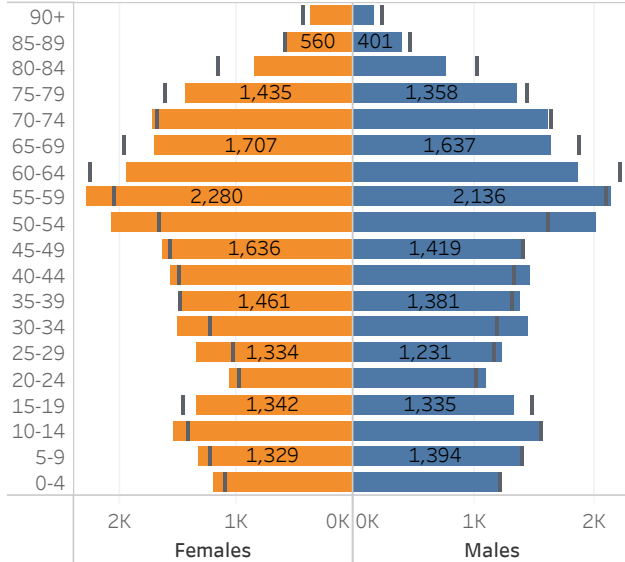

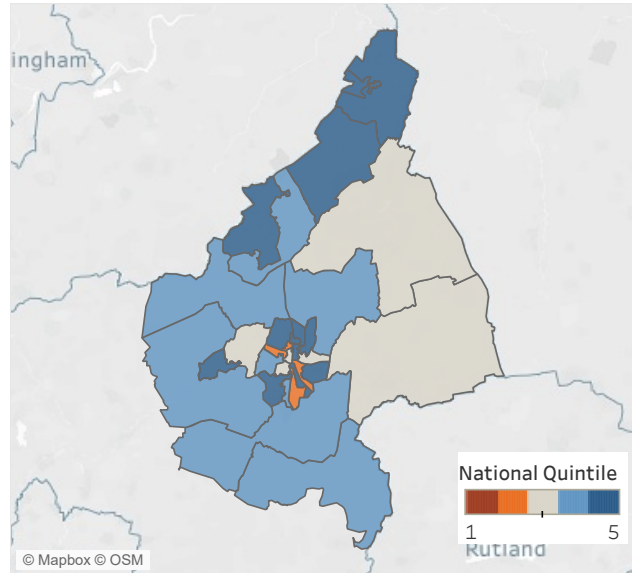
Population pyramid

Age and sex profile of residents, bars indicate 2022 mid year population estimates, lines show projected 2027 population.



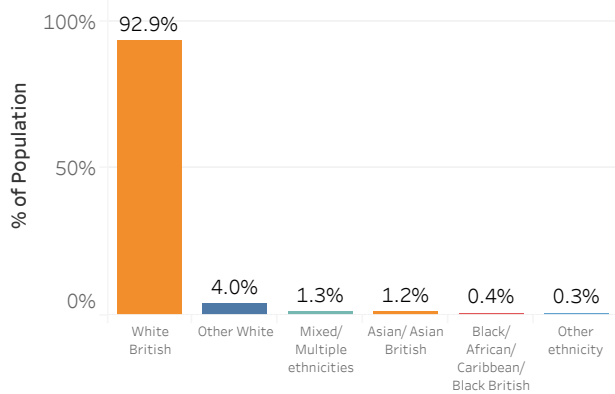
Index of Multiple Deprivation map

LSOA map showing national quintile performance of index of multiple deprivation score.



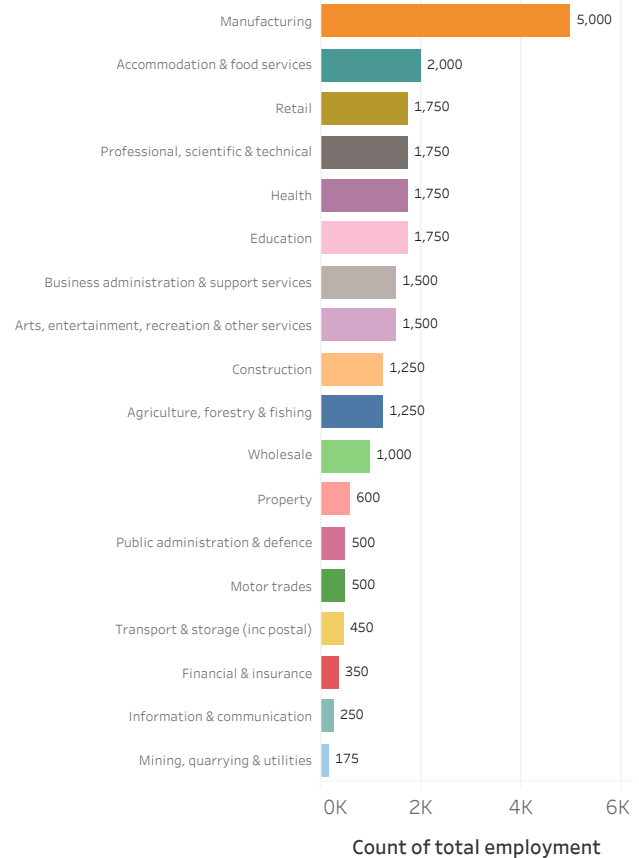
Ethnicity

Percentage of 2021 population by broad ethnic group.



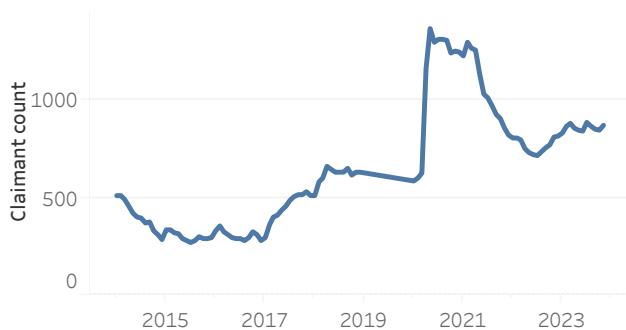
Occupations

Wider determinants

The number of premises licensed to sell alcohol per square kilometre for Melton in 2021/22 is 0.5, this is significantly better than the England value of 1.3.



The percentage of the local authority population living in areas at highest risk of food insecurity for Melton in 2021 is 2.9%, this value falls into the 2nd best quintile in England.



The air pollution: fine particulate matter (new method - concentrations of total PM2.5) for Melton in 2021 is 6.9 µg/m3, this is not compared to the England value of 7.4 µg/m3.



The percentage of people in employment for Melton in 2022/23 is 88.2%, this is significantly better than the England value of 75.7%.



The average weekly earnings for Melton in 2021 is £393.7, this is significantly worse than the England value of £496.0.



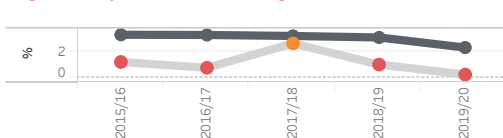
The the percentage of the population with a physical or mental long term health condition in employment (aged 16 to 64) for Melton in 2022/23 is 79.8%, this is similar to the England value of 65.3%.



The rate of violence offences per 1,000 population for Melton in 2021/22 is 26.7 per 1,000, this is not compared to the England value of 34.9 per 1,000.



The percentage of adults cycling for travel at least three days per week for Melton in 2019/20 is 0.3%, this is significantly worse than the England value of 2.3%.



The affordability of home ownership ratio (where a higher ratio indicates that on average, it is less affordable for a resident to purchase a house in their local authority district) for Melton in 2021 is 10.9, this is not compared to the England value of 9.1.

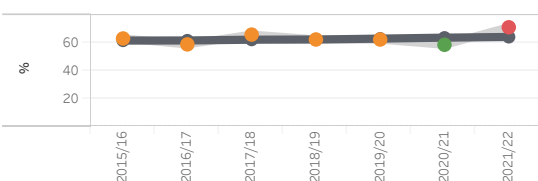


The percentage of the population living in fuel poverty for Melton in 2021 is 12.7%, this is not compared to the England value of 13.1%.



Health behaviours

The percentage of adults (aged 18 plus) classified as overweight or obese for Melton in 2021/22 is 70.7%, this is significantly worse than the England value of 63.8%.



The smoking prevalence in adults (18+) - current smokers (APS) for Melton in 2022 is 10.8%, this is similar to the England value of 12.7%.



The percentage of physically active adults for Melton in 2021/22 is 68.5%, this is similar to the England value of 67.3%.



The percentage of adults aged 16 and over meeting the '5-a-day' fruit and vegetable consumption recommendations for Melton in 2021/22 is 35.9%, this is similar to the England value of 32.5%.

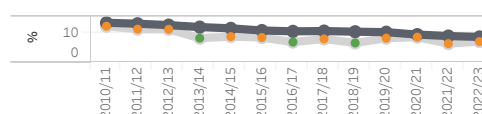

Early years

The proportion of low birth weight of term babies for Melton in 2021 is 2.0%, this is similar to the England value of 2.8%.



The proportion of women smoking at time of delivery for Melton in 2022/23 is 7.2%, this is similar to the England value of 8.8%.



The infant mortality rate for Melton in 2019 - 21 is 2.3 per 1,000, this is similar to the England value of 3.9 per 1,000.

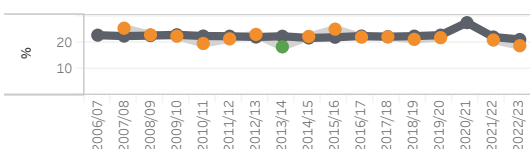


The rate of premature births (less than 37 weeks gestation) for Melton in 2019 - 21 is 65.8 per 1,000, this is similar to the England value of 77.9 per 1,000.

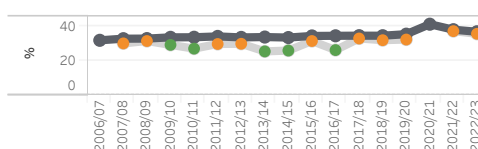


Wider determinants

The prevalence of overweight children (including obesity) in Reception for Melton in 2022/23 is 18.9%, this is similar to the England value of 21.3%.



The prevalence of overweight children (including obesity) in Year 6 for Melton in 2022/23 is 35.4%, this is similar to the England value of 36.6%.



The percentage of physically active children and young people for Melton in 2021/22 is 52.5%, this is similar to the England value of 47.2%.

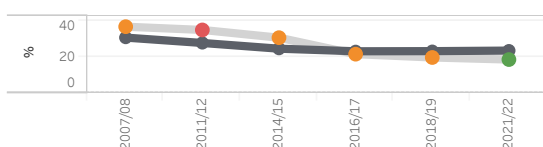
The percentage of children in absolute low income families (under 16s) for Melton in 2021/22 is 14.6%, this is similar to the England value of 15.3%.

Pupil absence for Melton in 2021/22 is 7.6%, this is similar to the England value of 7.6%.

The average attainment 8 score for Melton in 2021/22 is 51.3, this is not compared to the England value of 48.7.

Outcomes

The percentage of 5 year olds with experience of visually obvious dental decay for Melton in 2021/22 is 18.7%, this is significantly better than the England value of 23.7%.



The rate of hospital admissions caused by unintentional and deliberate injuries in children (aged 0 to 14 years) for Melton in 2021/22 is 54.9 per 10,000, this is significantly better than the England value of 84.3 per 10,000.



The rate of hospital admissions caused by unintentional and deliberate injuries in young people (aged 15 to 24 years) for Melton in 2021/22 is 72.5 per 10,000, this is significantly better than the England value of 118.6 per 10,000.



The under 18s conception rate for Melton in 2021 is 10.7 per 1,000, this is similar to the England value of 13.1 per 1,000.

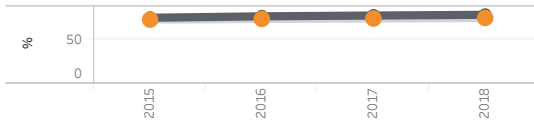

Diagnoses



The estimated diabetes diagnosis rate for Melton in 2018 is 74.3%, this is similar to the England value of 78.0%.



The estimated dementia diagnosis rate (aged 65 and older) for Melton in 2023 is 60.4%, this is similar to the target value of 66.7%.



The all new STI diagnoses rate per 100,000 for Melton in 2022 is 460 per 100,000, this is significantly lower than the England value of 694 per 100,000.



The cancer screening coverage: breast cancer for Melton in 2022 is 72.1%, this is significantly better than the England value of 65.2%.

Admissions

The rate of admission episodes for alcohol-related conditions (Narrow) for Melton in 2021/22 is 420 per 100,000, this is significantly better than the England value of 494 per 100,000.



The rate of rate of emergency hospital admissions due to falls in people aged 65 and over for Melton in 2021/22 is 1,599 per 100,000, this is significantly better than the England value of 2,100 per 100,000.



Mortality



The under 75 mortality rate from all causes for Melton in 2021 is 345.7 per 100,000, this is similar to the England value of 363.4 per 100,000.



The under 75 mortality rate from causes considered preventable for Melton in 2021 is 154.9 per 100,000, this is similar to the England value of 183.2 per 100,000.



The under 75 mortality rate from cancer for Melton in 2021 is 149.0 per 100,000, this is similar to the England value of 121.5 per 100,000.



The under 75 mortality rate from all cardiovascular diseases for Melton in 2021 is 60.7 per 100,000, this is similar to the England value of 76.0 per 100,000.



The under 75 mortality rate from respiratory disease for Melton in 2021 is 20.1 per 100,000, this is similar to the England value of 26.5 per 100,000.



The winter mortality index for Melton in Aug 2020 - Jul 2021 is 19.7%, this is similar to the England value of 36.2%.

Life Expectancy

The life expectancy at birth for males for Melton in 2021 is 78.8 years, this is similar to the England value of 78.7 years.



The life expectancy at birth for females for Melton in 2021 is 83.9 years, this is similar to England value of 82.8 years.
