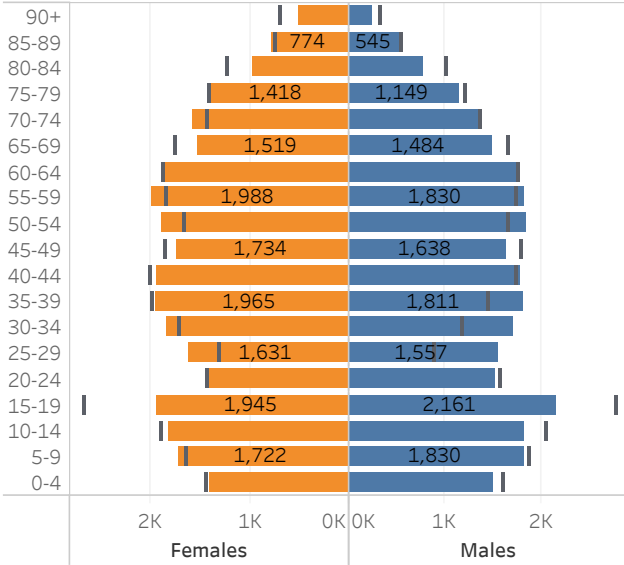

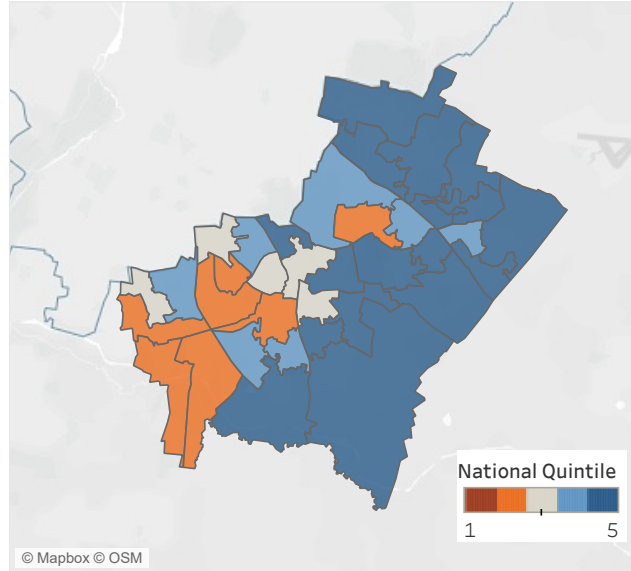
## Population pyramid

Age and sex profile of residents, bars indicate 2022 mid year population estimates, lines show projected 2027 population.



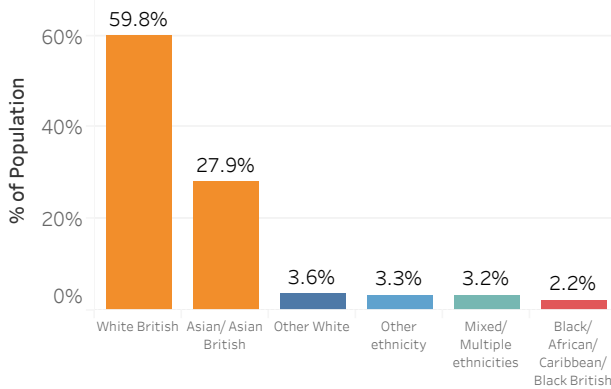
## Index of Multiple Deprivation map

LSOA map showing national quintile performance of index of multiple deprivation score.



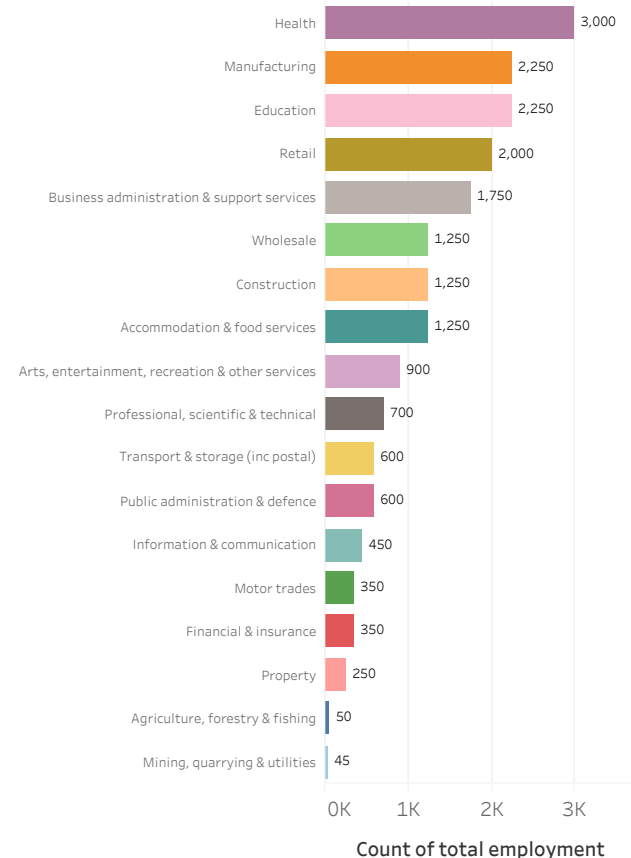
## Ethnicity

### Wider determinants

The number of premises licensed to sell alcohol per square kilometre for Oadby and Wigston in 2021/22 is 4.1, this is significantly worse than the England value of 1.3.



The percentage of the local authority population living in areas at highest risk of food insecurity for Oadby and Wigston in 2021 is 5.8%, this value falls into the 2nd best quintile in England.



The air pollution: fine particulate matter (new method - concentrations of total PM2.5) for Oadby and Wigston in 2021 is 8.3 µg/m3, this is not compared to the England value of 7.4 µg/m3.



The percentage of people in employment for Oadby and Wigston in 2022/23 is 73.0%, this is similar to the England value of 75.7%.



The average weekly earnings for Oadby and Wigston in 2021 is £436.4, this is similar to the England value of £496.0.



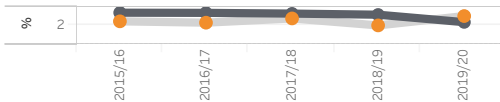
The percentage of the population with a physical or mental long term health condition in employment (aged 16 to 64) for Oadby and Wigston in 2022/23 is 78.6%, this is similar to the England value of 65.3%.



The rate of violence offences per 1,000 population for Oadby and Wigston in 2021/22 is 28.9 per 1,000, this is not compared to the England value of 34.9 per 1,000.



The percentage of adults cycling for travel at least three days per week for Oadby and Wigston in 2019/20 is 3.0%, this is similar to the England value of 2.3%.



The rate of households owed a duty under the Homelessness Reduction Act for Oadby and Wigston in 2021/22 is 5.8 per 1,000, this is significantly better than the England value of 11.7 per 1,000.

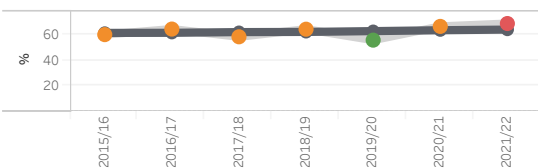


The percentage living in fuel poverty for Oadby and Wigston in 2021 is 10.2%, this is not compared to the England value of 13.1%.



### Health behaviours

The percentage of adults (aged 18 plus) classified as overweight or obese for Oadby and Wigston in 2021/22 is 68.5%, this is significantly worse than the England value of 63.8%.



The smoking prevalence in adults (18+) - current smokers (APS) for Oadby and Wigston in 2022 is 7.7%, this is similar to the England value of 12.7%.



The percentage of physically active adults for Oadby and Wigston in 2021/22 is 57.6%, this is significantly worse than the England value of 67.3%.



The percentage of adults aged 16 and over meeting the '5-a-day' fruit and vegetable consumption recommendations for Oadby and Wigston in 2021/22 is 27.2%, this is significantly worse than the England value of 32.5%.

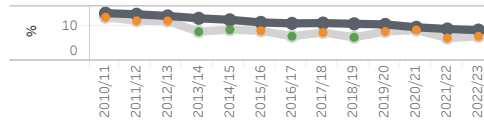

### Early years

The proportion of low birth weight of term babies for Oadby and Wigston in 2021 is 4.1%, this is similar to the England value of 2.8%.



The proportion of women smoking at time of delivery for Oadby and Wigston in 2022/23 is 7.0%, this is similar to the England value of 8.8%.



The infant mortality rate for Oadby and Wigston in 2019 - 21 is 2.6 per 1,000, this is similar to the England value of 3.9 per 1,000.

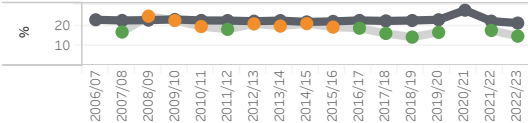


The rate of premature births (less than 37 weeks gestation) for Oadby and Wigston in 2019 - 21 is 79.7 per 1,000, this is similar to the England value of 77.9 per 1,000.

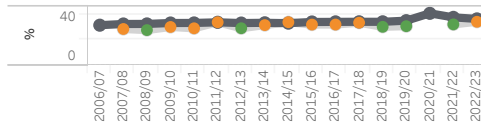


### Wider determinants

The prevalence of overweight children (including obesity) in Reception for Oadby and Wigston in 2022/23 is 14.8%, this is significantly better than the England value of 21.3%.



The prevalence of overweight children (including obesity) in Year 6 for Oadby and Wigston in 2022/23 is 34.3%, this is similar to the England value of 36.6%.



The rate of households with dependent children owed a duty under the Homelessness Reduction Act for Oadby and Wigston in 2021/22 is 7.0 per 1,000, this is significantly better than the England value of 14.4 per 1,000.



The percentage of children in absolute low income families (under 16s) for Oadby and Wigston in 2021/22 is 16.9%, this is significantly worse than the England value of 15.3%.



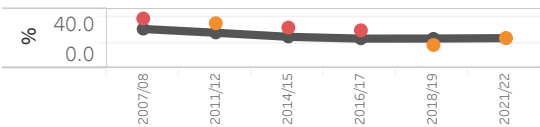
Pupil absence for Oadby and Wigston in 2021/22 is 6.7%, this is significantly better than the England value of 7.6%.



The average attainment 8 score for Oadby and Wigston in 2021/22 is 50.5, this is not compared to the England value of 48.7.

### Outcomes

The percentage of 5 year olds with experience of visually obvious dental decay for Oadby and Wigston in 2021/22 is 23.8%, this is similar to the England value of 23.7%.



The rate of hospital admissions caused by unintentional and deliberate injuries in children (aged 0-14 years) for Oadby and Wigston in 2021/22 is 40.6 per 10,000, this is significantly better than the England value of 84.3 per 10,000.



The rate of hospital admissions caused by unintentional and deliberate injuries in young people (aged 15-24 years) for Oadby and Wigston in 2021/22 is 84.3 per 10,000, this is significantly better than the England value of 118.6 per 10,000.

The under 18s conception rate for Oadby and Wigston in 2021 is 9.0 per 1,000, this is similar to the England value of 13.1 per 1,000.

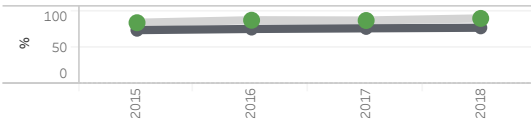

### Diagnoses



The estimated diabetes diagnosis rate for Oadby and Wigston in 2018 is 90.9%, this is significantly better than the England value of 78.0%.



The Estimated dementia diagnosis rate (aged 65 and older) for Oadby and Wigston in 2023 is 57.6%, this is significantly worse than the target of 66.7%.



The all new STI diagnosis rate / 100,000 for Oadby and Wigston in 2022 is 445 per 100,000, this is significantly lower than the England value of 694 per 100,000.



The percentage of cancers diagnosed at stages 1 & 2 for Oadby and Wigston in 2020 is 43.4%, this is significantly worse than the England value of 52.3%.

### Admissions

The rate of admission episodes for alcohol-related conditions (Narrow) for Oadby and Wigston in 2021/22 is 379 per 100,000, this is significantly better than the England value of 494 per 100,000.



The rate of emergency hospital admissions due to falls in people aged 65 and over for Oadby and Wigston in 2021/22 is 1,708 per 100,000, this is significantly better than the England value of 2,100 per 100,000.



### Mortality



The under 75 mortality rate from all causes for Oadby and Wigston in 2021 is 337.7 per 100,000, this is similar to the England value of 363.4 per 100,000.



The under 75 mortality rate from causes considered preventable for Oadby and Wigston in 2021 is 156.1 per 100,000, this is similar to the England value of 183.2 per 100,000.



The under 75 mortality rate from cancer for Oadby and Wigston in 2021 is 117.6 per 100,000, this is similar to the England value of 121.5 per 100,000.



The under 75 mortality rate from all cardiovascular diseases for Oadby and Wigston in 2021 is 78.2 per 100,000, this is similar to the England value of 76.0 per 100,000.



The under 75 mortality rate from respiratory disease for Oadby and Wigston in 2021 is 21.6 per 100,000, this is similar to the England value of 26.5 per 100,000.



The winter mortality index for Oadby and Wigston in Aug 2020 - Jul 2021 is 58.6%, this is significantly worse than the England value of 36.2%.

### Life Expectancy

The life expectancy at birth for males for Oadby and Wigston in 2021 is 78.9 years, this is similar to the England value of 78.7 years.



The life expectancy at birth for females for Oadby and Wigston in 2021 is 83.4 years, this is similar to the England value of 82.8 years.
