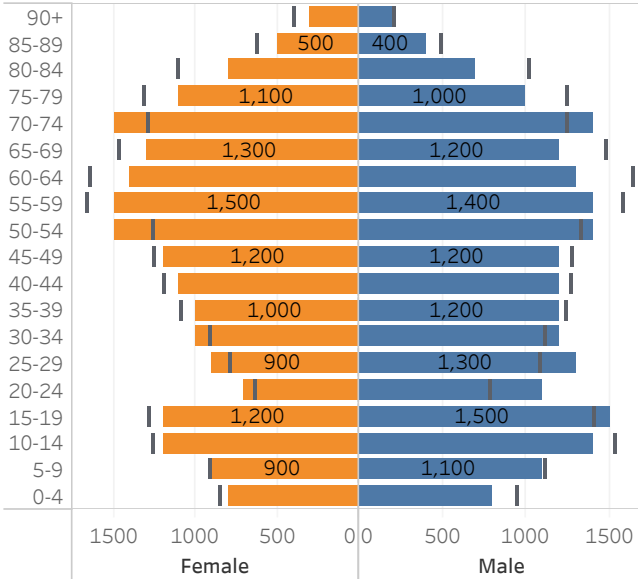

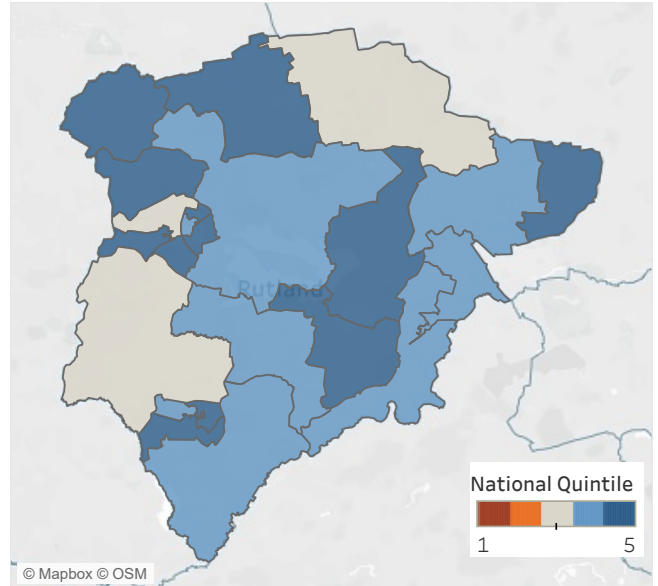
### Population pyramid

Age and sex profile of residents, bars indicate 2021 census population, lines show projected 2027 population.



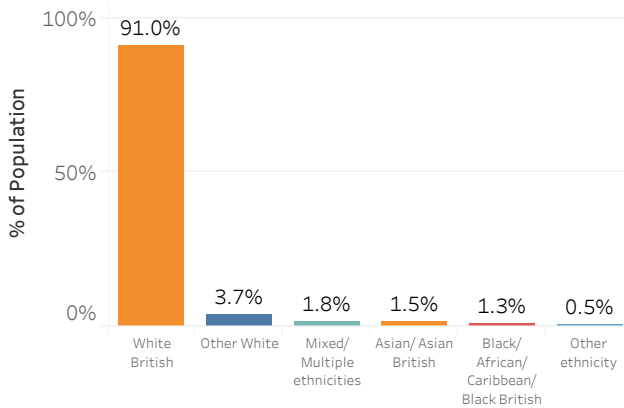
### Index of Multiple Deprivation map

LSOA map showing national quintile performance of index of multiple deprivation score.



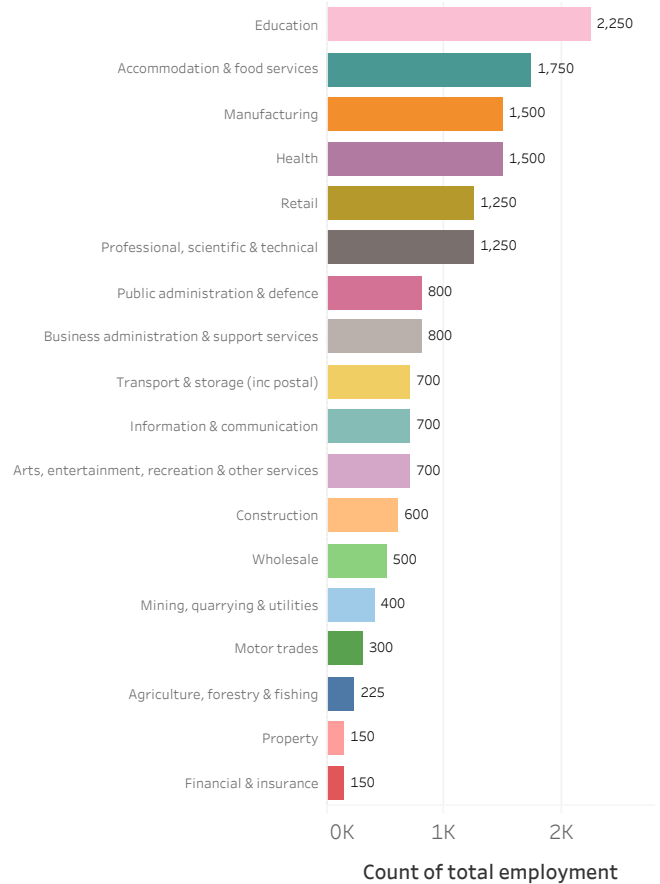
### Ethnicity

## Wider determinants

The air pollution: fine particulate matter (historic indicator) for Rutland in 2020 is 6.2 µg/m<sup>3</sup> this is not compared to the England value of 6.9 µg/m<sup>3</sup>.



The density of fast food outlets for Rutland in 2014 is 63.1 per 100,000 this is similar to the England value of 88.2 per 100,000.



The percentage of adult carers who have as much social contact as they would like for Rutland in 2018/19 is 38.2% this is similar to England value of 32.5%.



The proportion of unpaid carers for Rutland in 2011 is 1.8% this is significantly better than the England value of 2.37%.



The average weekly earnings for Rutland in 2021 is £551.3 this is similar to the England value of £496.0.



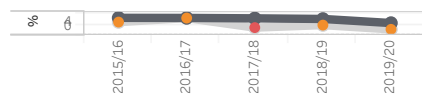
The gap in the employment rate between those with a physical or mental long term health condition (aged 16 to 64) and the overall employment rate for Rutland in 2021/22 is 6.8 percentage points this is similar to the England value of 9.9 percentage points.



The violence offences per 1,000 population for Rutland in 2021/22 is 17.3 per 1,000 this is not compared to the England value of 34.9 per 1,000.



The percentage of adults cycling for travel at least three days per week for Rutland in 2019/20 is 1.1 % this is similar to the England value of 2.3 %.



The rate of households owed a duty under the Homelessness Reduction Act for Rutland in 2020/21 is 4.9 per 1,000 this is significantly better than the England value of 11.3 per 1,000.

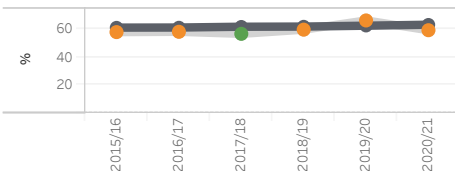


The percentage of the population living in fuel poverty for Rutland in 2020 is 11.9% this is not compared to the England value of 13.2%.



## Health behaviours

The percentage of adults (aged 18+) classified as overweight or obese for Rutland in 2020/21 is 59.5% this is similar to the England value of 63.5%.



The smoking prevalence in adults (18+) - current smokers (APS) for Rutland in 2021 is 13.0% this is similar to the England value of 13.0%.



The percentage of physically active adults for Rutland in 2020/21 is 74.0% this is significantly better than the England value of 65.9%.



The proportion of the population meeting the recommended '5-a-day' on a 'usual day' (adults) for Rutland in 2019/20 is 64.9% this is significantly better than the England value of 55.4%.

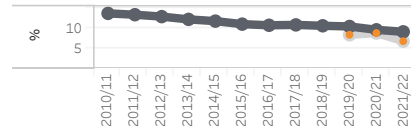

## Early years

The proportion of low birth weight of term babies for Rutland in 2020 is 1.7% this is similar to the England value of 2.9%.



The proportion of women smoking at time of delivery for Rutland in 2021/22 is 6.8% this is similar to the England value of 9.1%.



The infant mortality rate for Rutland in 2018 - 20 is 3.4 per 1,000 this is similar to the England value of 3.9 per 1,000.

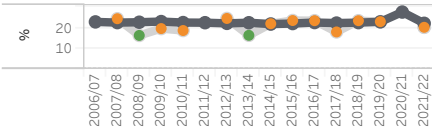


The proportion of baby's first feed being breastmilk for Rutland in 2018/19 is 77.6% this is similar to the England value of 67.4%.

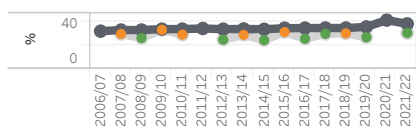


## Wider determinants

The prevalence of overweight children (including obesity) in Reception for Rutland in 2021/22 is 20.3% this is similar to the England value of 22.3%.



The prevalence of overweight children (including obesity) in Year 6 for Rutland in 2021/22 is 30.2% this is significantly better than the England value of 37.8%.



The percentage of school pupils with special educational needs for Rutland in School age children in 2018 is 13.1% this is significantly better than the England value of 14.4%.



The proportion of children in absolute low income families (under 16s) for Rutland in 2020/21 is 6.7% this is significantly better than the England value of 15.1%.



The proportion of children providing unpaid care (aged 0-15) for Rutland in 2011 is 0.9% this is similar to the England value of 1.1%.

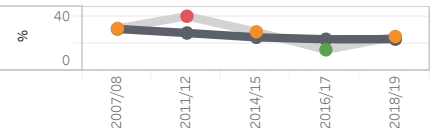


The average Attainment 8 score for Rutland in 2020/21 is 54.3 this is significantly better than the England value of 50.9.



## Outcomes

The percentage of 5 year olds with experience of visually obvious dental decay for Rutland in 2018/19 is 25.3% this is similar to the England value of 23.4%.



The rate of hospital admissions caused by unintentional and deliberate injuries in children (aged 0-4 years) for Rutland in 2020/21 is 84.5 per 10,000 this is similar to the England value of 108.7 per 10,000.



The rate of hospital admissions caused by unintentional and deliberate injuries in children (aged 0-14 years) for Rutland in 2020/21 is 49.6 per 10,000 this is significantly better than the England value of 75.7 per 10,000.



The under 18s conception rate for Rutland in 2020 is 5.7 per 1,000 this is similar to the England value of 13.0 per 1,000.

## Diagnoses

The estimated diabetes diagnosis rate for Rutland in 2018 is 73.8% this is similar to the England value of 78.0%.

The estimated dementia diagnosis rate (aged 65 and over) for Rutland in 2022 is 50.3% this is significantly worse than the target value of 66.7%.

The all new STI diagnoses rate per 100,000 for Rutland in 2021 is 262 per 100,000 this is significantly lower than the England value of 551.0 per 100,000.

The percentage of cancers diagnosed at stages 1 & 2 for Rutland in 2019 is 53.3% this is similar to the England value of 55.0%.

## Healthcare

The Admission episodes for alcohol-related conditions (Narrow): New method. This indicator uses a new set of attributable fractions, and so differ from that originally published. for Rutland in 2020/21 is 304 per 100,000 this is significantly better than the England value of 456 per 100,000.

The hip fracture rate in people aged 65 and over for Rutland in 2020/21 is 608 per 100,000 this is similar to the England value of 529 per 100,000.

The shingles vaccination coverage (71 years) for Rutland in 2019/20 is 31.4% this is significantly worse than the goal value of 50-60%.

The rate of emergency hospital admissions due to falls in people aged 65 and over for Rutland in 2020/21 is 1,536 per 100,000 this is significantly better than the England value of 2,023.0 per 100,000.

## Mortality

The under 75 mortality rate from causes considered preventable (2019 definition) for Rutland in 2020 is 68.2 per 100,000 this is significantly better than the England value of 140.5 per 100,000.

The under 75 mortality rate from liver disease for Rutland in 2017 - 19 is 13.9 per 100,000 this is similar to the England value of 18.8 per 100,000.

The under 75 mortality rate from cancer for Rutland in 2017 - 19 is 110.1 per 100,000 this is similar to the England value of 129.2 per 100,000.

The under 75 mortality rate from all cardiovascular diseases for Rutland in 2017 - 19 is 43.6 per 100,000 this is significantly better than the England value of 70.4 per 100,000.

The under 75 mortality rate from respiratory disease for Rutland in 2017 - 19 is 14.6 per 100,000 this is significantly better than the England value of 33.6 per 100,000.

The excess winter deaths index for Rutland in Aug 2019 - Jul 2020 is 50.2% this is significantly worse than the England value of 17.4%.

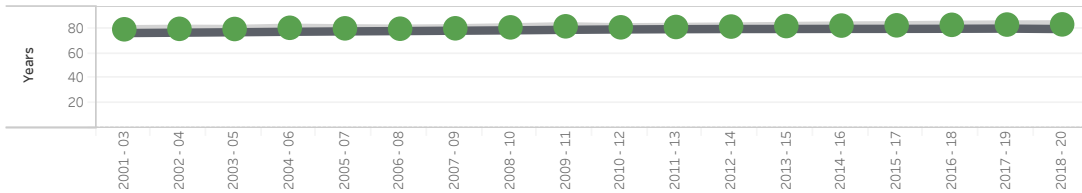

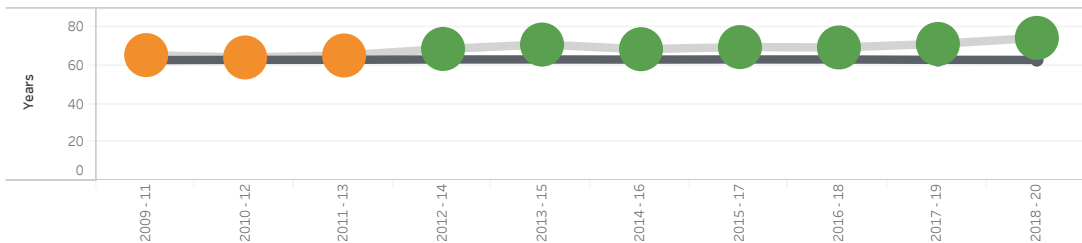

The life expectancy at birth for males for Rutland in 2018 - 20 is 83.2 years this is significantly better than England value of 79.4 years.

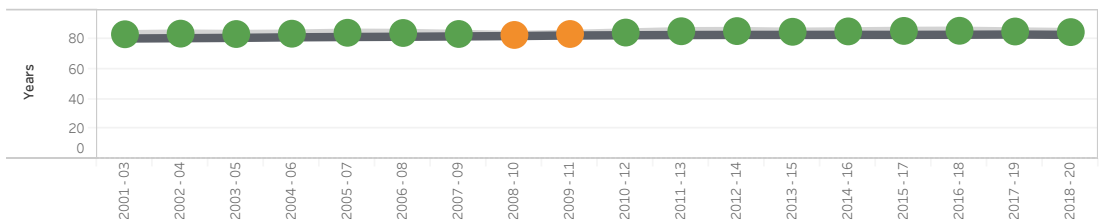


The healthy life expectancy at birth for males for Rutland in 2018 - 20 is 74.7 years this is significantly better than England value of 63.1 years.

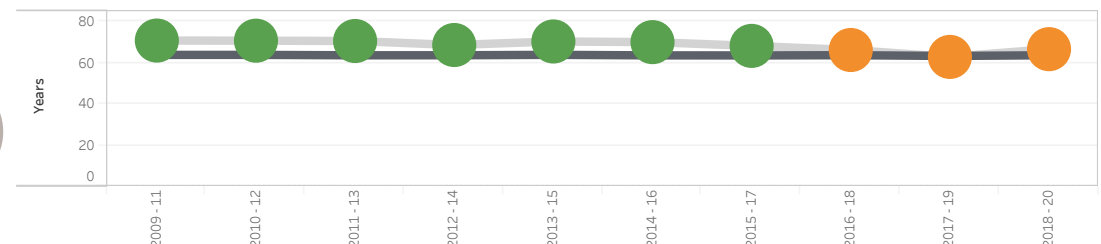


## Female Life Expectancy
