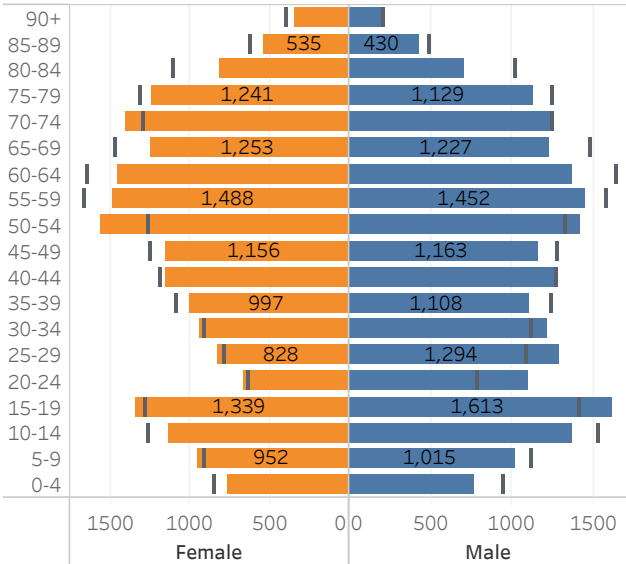

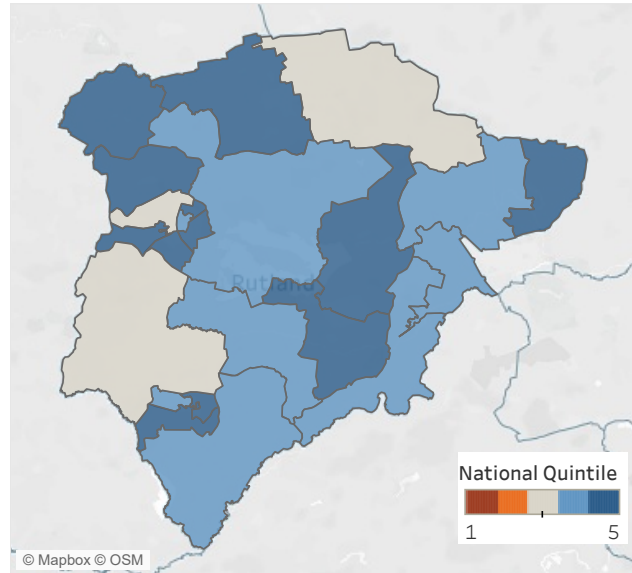
Population pyramid

Age and sex profile of residents, bars indicate 2022 mid year population estimates, lines show projected 2027 population.



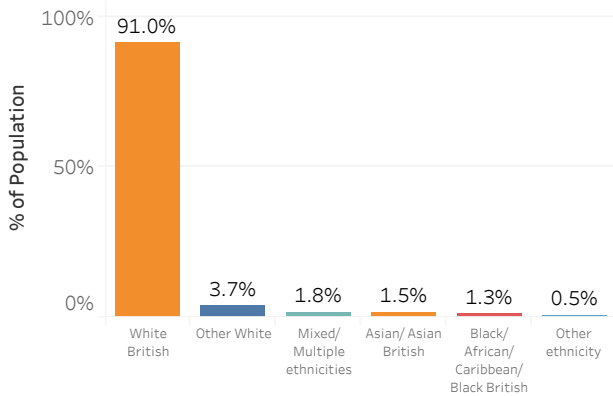
Index of Multiple Deprivation map

LSOA map showing national quintile performance of index of multiple deprivation score.



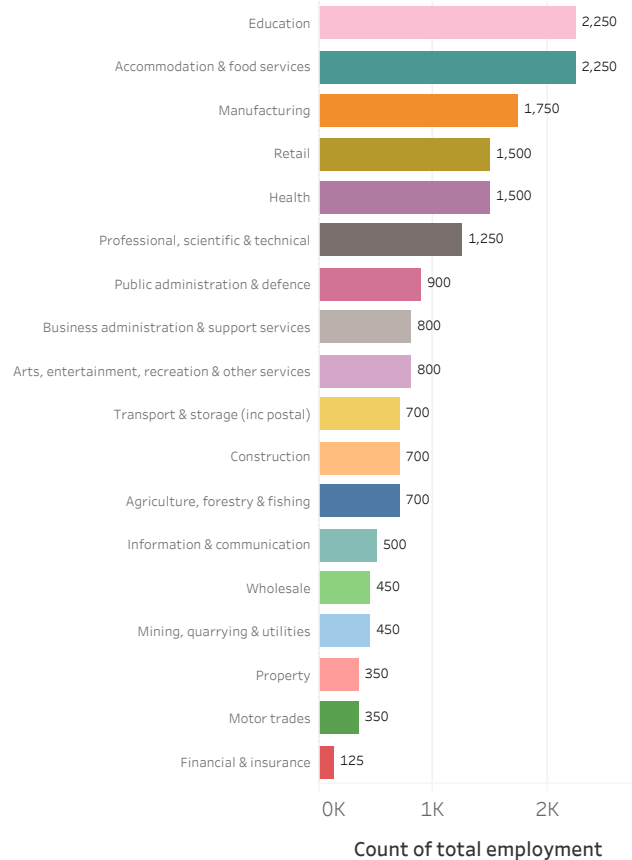

The air pollution: fine particulate matter (new method - concentrations of total PM2.5) for Rutland in 2021 is 6.9 µg/m3, this is not compared to the England value of 7.4 µg/m3.




The percentage of the local authority population living in areas at highest risk of food insecurity for Rutland in 2021 is 0.0%, this value falls into the best quintile in England.




The percentage of adult carers who have as much social contact as they would like for Rutland in 2021/22 is 27.0%, this is similar to the England value of 28.0%.




The percentage of people in employment for Rutland in 2022/23 is 77.1%, this is similar to the England value of 75.7%.




The average weekly earnings for Rutland in 2021 is £551.3, this is similar to the England value of £496.0.




The gap in the employment rate between those with a physical or mental long term health condition (aged 16 to 64) and the overall employment rate for Rutland in 2022/23 is 3.3 percentage points, this is similar to the England value of 10.4 percentage points.




The rate of violence offences per 1,000 population for Rutland in 2021/22 is 17.3 per 1,000, this is not compared to the England value of 34.9 per 1,000.




The percentage of adults cycling for travel at least three days per week for Rutland in 2019/20 is 1.1%, this is similar to the England value of 2.3 %.

The rate of households owed a duty under the Homelessness Reduction Act for Rutland in 2021/22 is 6.1 per 1,000, this is significantly better than the England value of 11.7 per 1,000.




The percentage of the population living in fuel poverty for Rutland in 2021 is 12.9%, this is not compared to the England value of 13.1%.




Health behaviours


The percentage of adults (aged 18 plus) classified as overweight or obese for Rutland in 2021/22 is 55.5%, this is significantly better than the England value of 63.8%.

The percentage of adults aged 16 and over meeting the '5-a-day' fruit and vegetable consumption recommendations (new method) for Rutland in 2021/22 is 39.5%, this is significantly better than the England value of 32.5%.

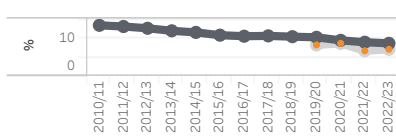
Early years



The proportion of low birth weight of term babies for Rutland in 2021 is 2.4%, this is similar to the England value of 2.8%.



The proportion of women smoking at time of delivery for Rutland in 2022/23 is 7.2%, this is similar to the England value of 8.8%.



The infant mortality rate for Rutland in 2019 - 21 is 2.4 per 1,000, this is similar to the England value of 3.9 per 1,000.



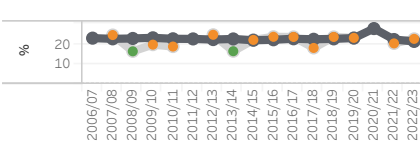
The proportion of baby's first feed being breastmilk for Rutland in 2020/21 is 86.1%, this is significantly better than the England value of 71.7%.



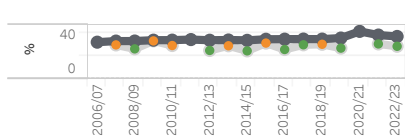
Wider determinants



The prevalence of overweight children (including obesity) in Reception for Rutland in 2022/23 is 22.6%, this is similar to the England value of 21.3%.



The prevalence of overweight children (including obesity) in Year 6 for Rutland in 2022/23 is 28.1%, this is significantly better than the England value of 36.6%.



The percentage of school pupils with special educational needs for Rutland in School age children in 2022/23 is 15.1%, this is significantly better than the England value of 17.3%.



The proportion of children in absolute low income families (under 16s) for Rutland in 2021/22 is 10.0%, this is significantly better than the England value of 15.3%.



The rate of children in care for Rutland in 2022 is 31.0 per 10,000, this is significantly better than the England value of 70.0 per 10,000.



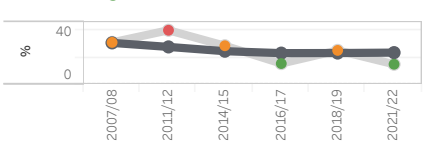
The average Attainment 8 score for Rutland in 2021/22 is 56.2, this is not compared to the England value of 48.7.



Outcomes



The percentage of 5 year olds with experience of visually obvious dental decay for Rutland in 2021/22 is 15.1%, this is significantly better than the England value of 23.7%.



The rate of hospital admissions caused by unintentional and deliberate injuries in children (aged 0 to 14 years) for Rutland in 2021/22 is 49.5 per 10,000, this is significantly better than the England value of 84.3 per 10,000.



The rate of hospital admissions caused by unintentional and deliberate injuries in young people (aged 15 to 24 years) for Rutland in 2021/22 is 92.4 per 10,000, this is similar to the England value of 118.6 per 10,000.



The rate of A&E attendances (under 18 years) for Rutland in 2021/22 is 296.5 per 1,000, this is significantly better than the England value of 439.8 per 1,000.

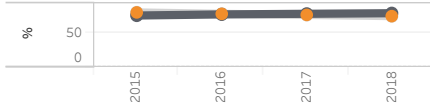

Diagnoses



The estimated diabetes diagnosis rate for Rutland in 2018 is 73.8%, this is similar to the England value of 78.0%.



The estimated dementia diagnosis rate (aged 65 and older) for Rutland in 2023 is 48.5%, this is significantly worse than the target value of 66.7%.



The all new STI diagnoses rate per 100,000 for Rutland in 2022 is 425 per 100,000, this is significantly lower than the England value of 694.2 per 100,000.



The percentage of cancers diagnosed at stages 1 and 2 for Rutland in 2020 is 57.2%, this is similar to the England value of 52.3%.



Healthcare



The rate of admission episodes for alcohol-related conditions (Narrow) for Rutland in 2021/22 is 315 per 100,000, this is significantly better than the England value of 494 per 100,000.



The hip fracture rate in people aged 65 and over for Rutland in 2021/22 is 528 per 100,000, this is similar to the England value of 551 per 100,000.



The shingles vaccination coverage (71 years) for Rutland in 2021/22 is 32.2%, this is significantly worse than the goal value of 60%.



The rate of emergency hospital admissions due to falls in people aged 65 and over for Rutland in 2021/22 is 1,565 per 100,000, this is significantly better than the England value of 2,099.9 per 100,000.



Mortality



The under 75 mortality rate from all causes for Rutland in 2021 is 220.8 per 100,000, this is significantly better than the England value of 363.4 per 100,000.



The deaths from stroke, all ages, standardised mortality ratio for Rutland in 2016 - 20 is 82.0 per 100, this is significantly better than the England value of 100.0 per 100.



The under 75 mortality rate from cancer for Rutland in 2021 is 102.2 per 100,000, this is similar to the England value of 121.5 per 100,000.



The under 75 mortality rate from all cardiovascular diseases for Rutland in 2021 is 29.6 per 100,000, this is significantly better than the England value of 76.0 per 100,000.



The under 75 mortality rate from causes considered preventable for Rutland in 2021 is 115.2 per 100,000, this is significantly better than the England value of 183.2 per 100,000.



The Winter mortality index for Rutland in Aug 2020 - Jul 2021 is 33.3%, this is similar to the England value of 36.2%.

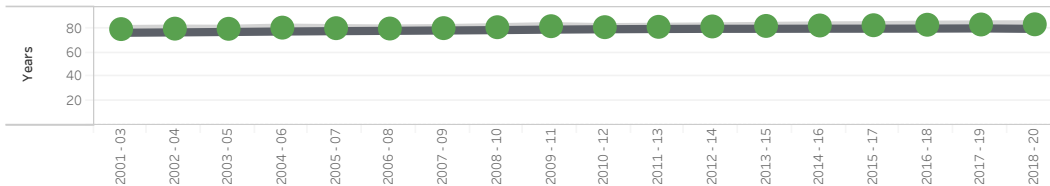

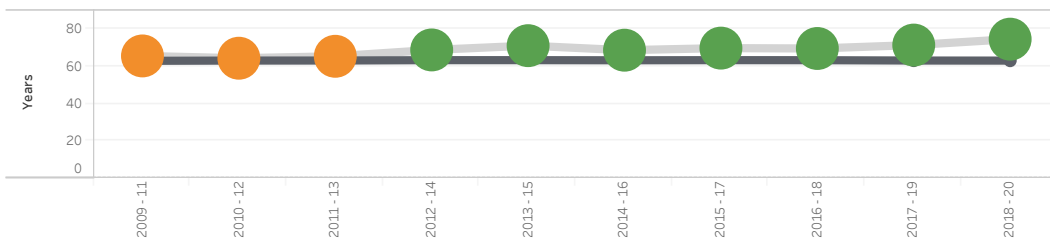

The life expectancy at birth for males for Rutland in 2018 - 20 is 83.2 years, this is significantly better than the England value of 79.4 years.

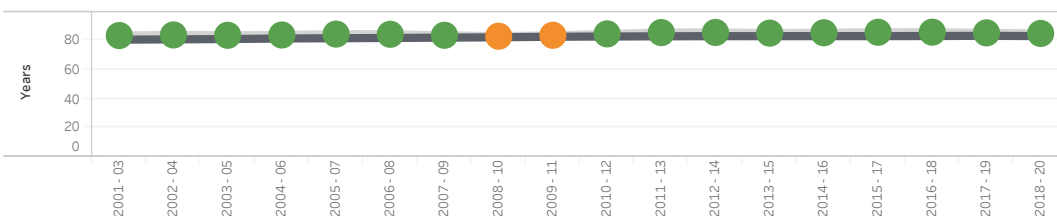


The healthy life expectancy at birth for males for Rutland in 2018 - 20 is 74.7 years, this is significantly better than England value of 63.1 years.

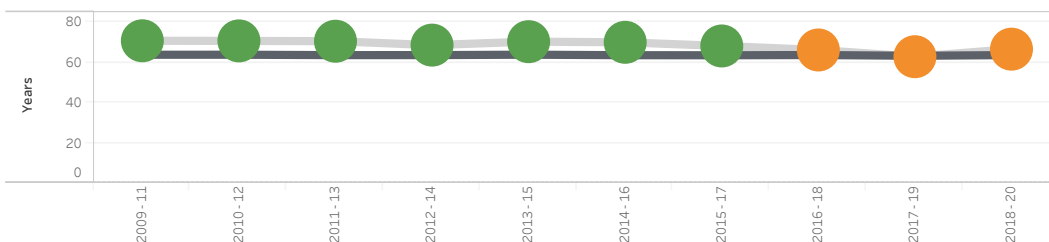


Female Life Expectancy
